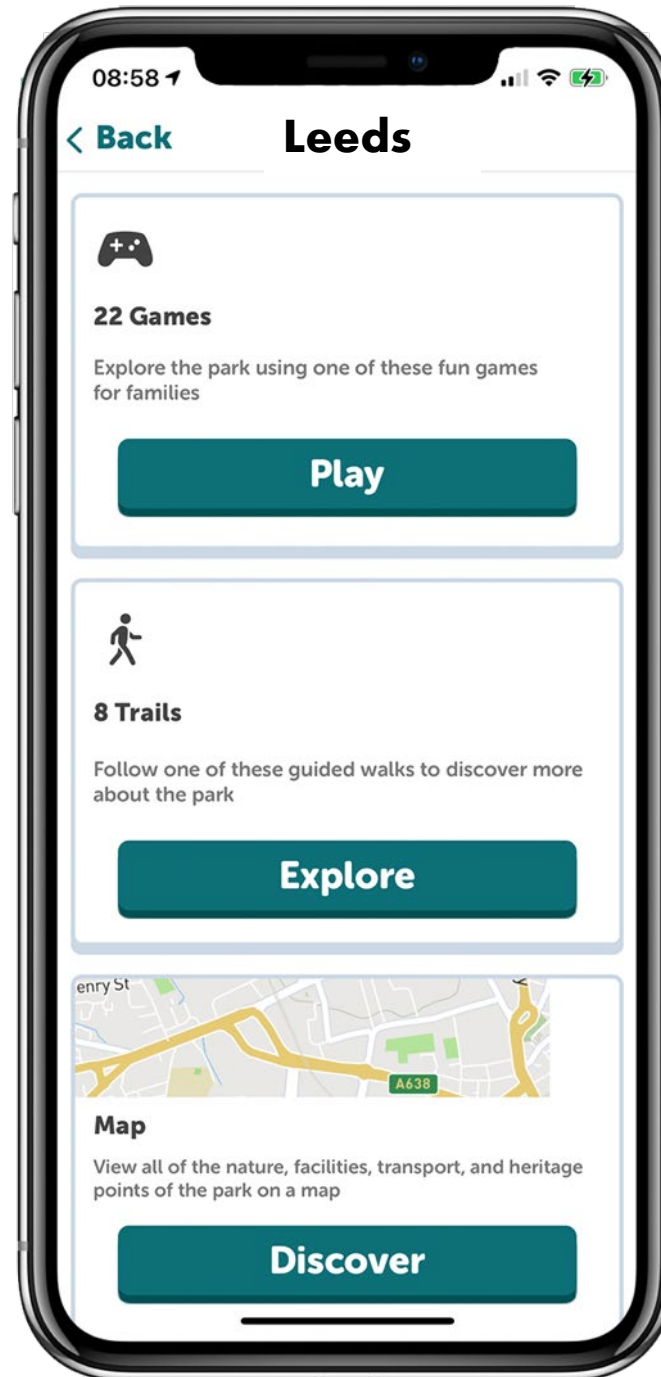

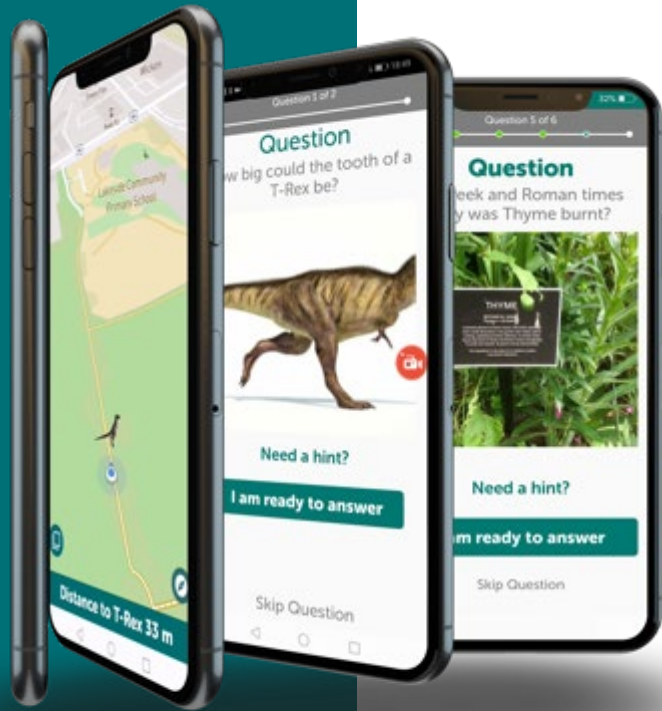
Trails

The detailed map has a lot of information to help people find out more about the city. More content is being added to this all the time.

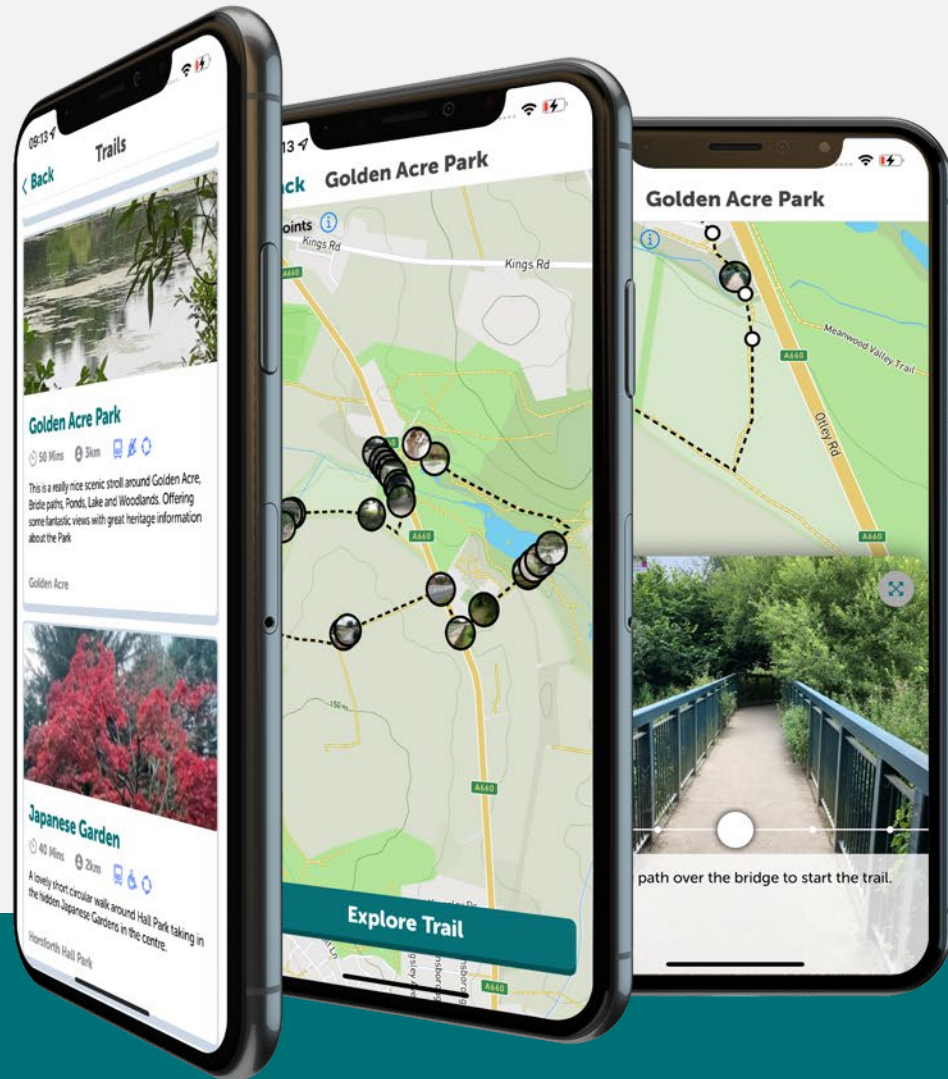


GAMES

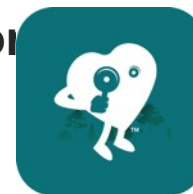
TRAILS

We are setting up LOTS of games and trails across Leeds for families to enjoy for



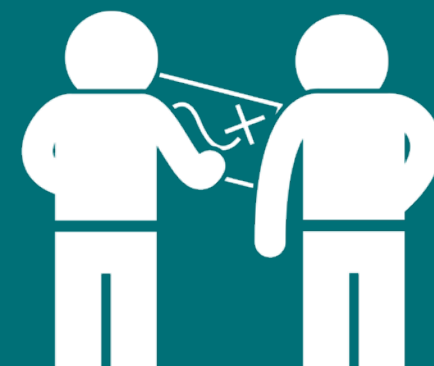
LOVE EXPLORING™

There will be lots of games to play in parks across Leeds and trails to follow across the city.

These can all be accessed through the Love Exploring App. They are free to play but you will need a compatible mobile phone to access them.



Most smart phones will work. iPhones need to be newer than an iPhone 6. Android is a little more complicated as there so many manufacturers. The app adapts the graphics in the games to the phone. You can find a list of fully compatible Android mobile phones [here](#). If your phone is not on this list then the games will work but with less sophisticated graphics.



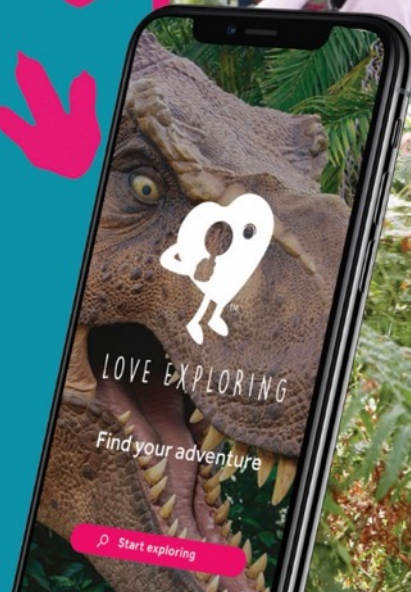
Almost **7,000** people have downloaded the app in Leeds since its launch in 2021. In a survey, **100%** of users recommended the app.

The top individual prize will be an iPad.

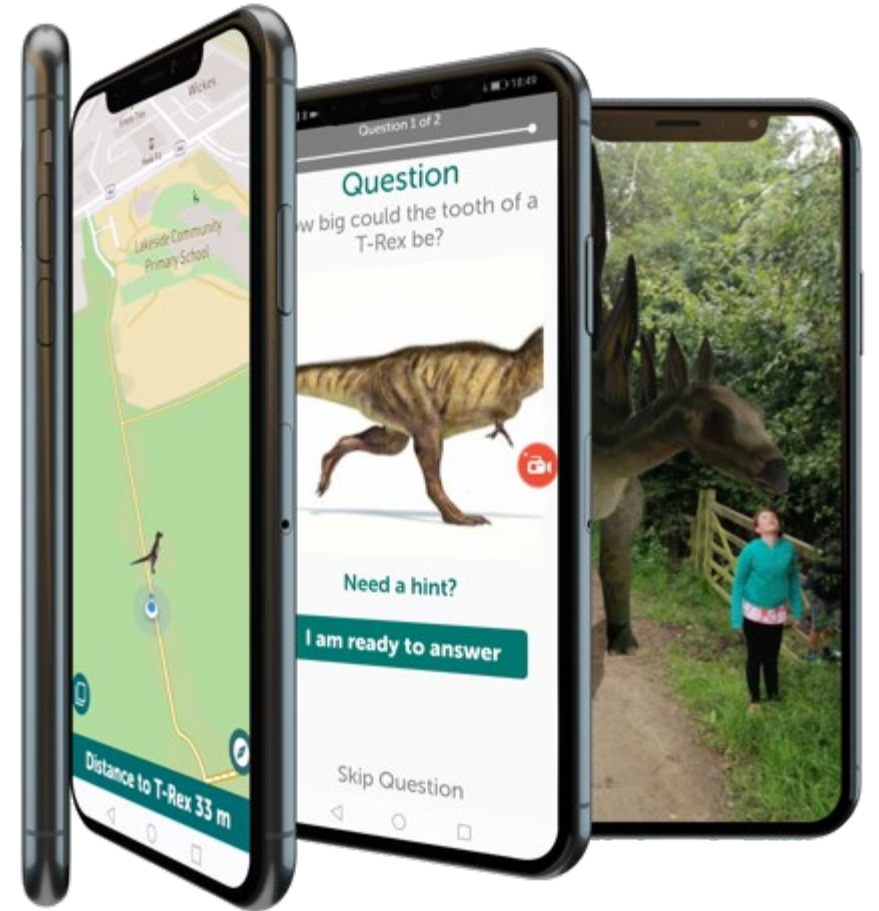
DID YOU PLAY THE DINOSAUR SAFARI YET?

You can play in lots of parks in Leeds. 72 thousand people played across the UK and they walked 505,303km looking for dinosaurs.

Each dinosaur is linked to a quiz question so everyone learns while they play.

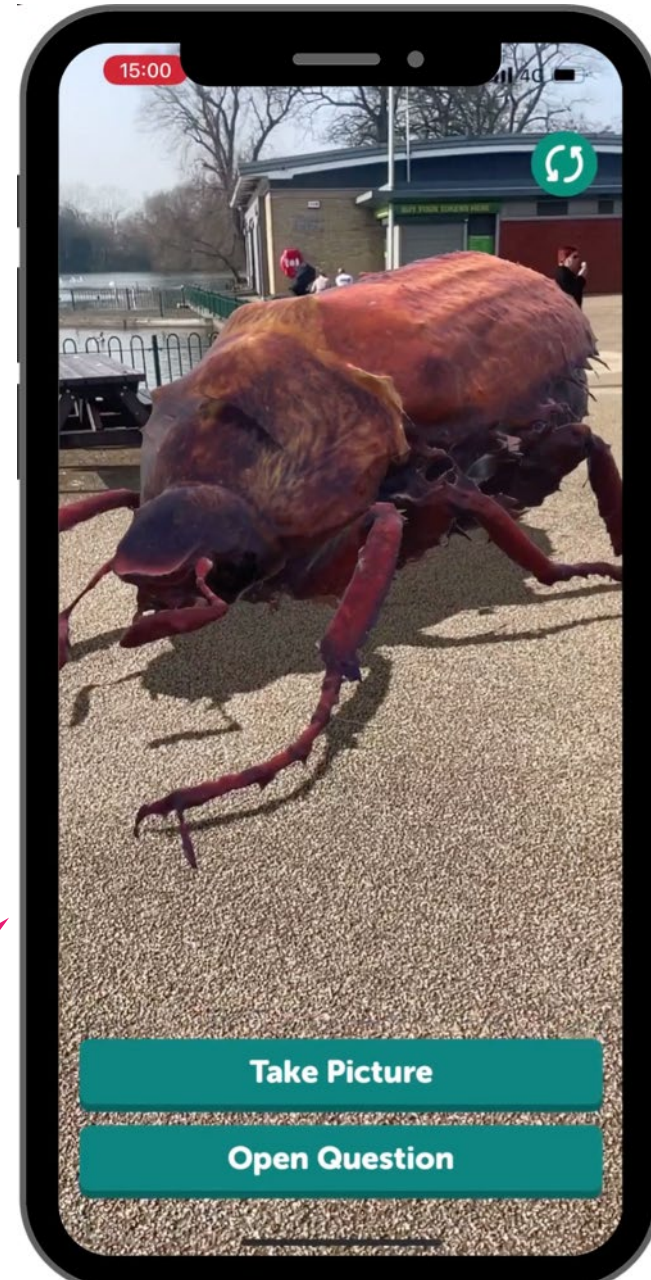



THE INTER-SCHOOL CHALLENGE

Players can link their accounts to their school so they can play the inter-school challenge.

This is a fun and free way to encourage people to get out and about. Players can link their activity to your school so when they walk trails and play games the school accrues points.

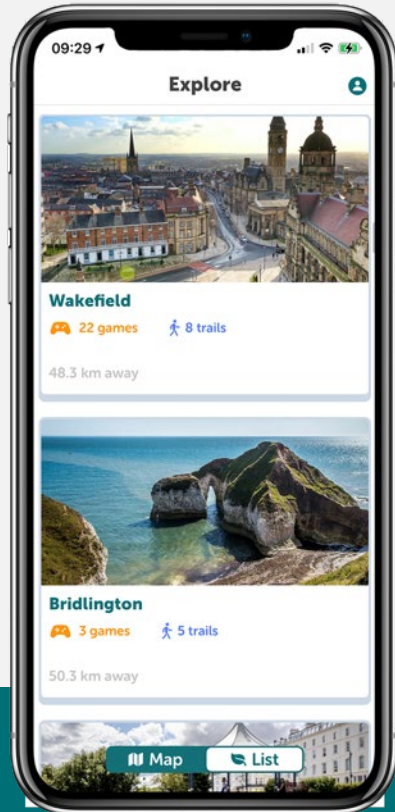

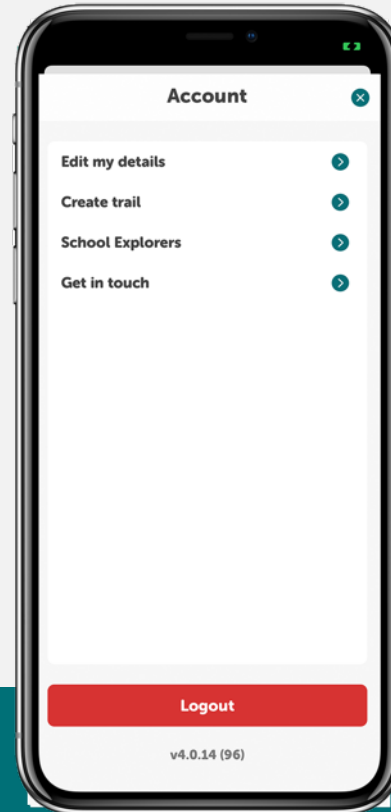
Linking your account to your school

It's easy to link your account to your school

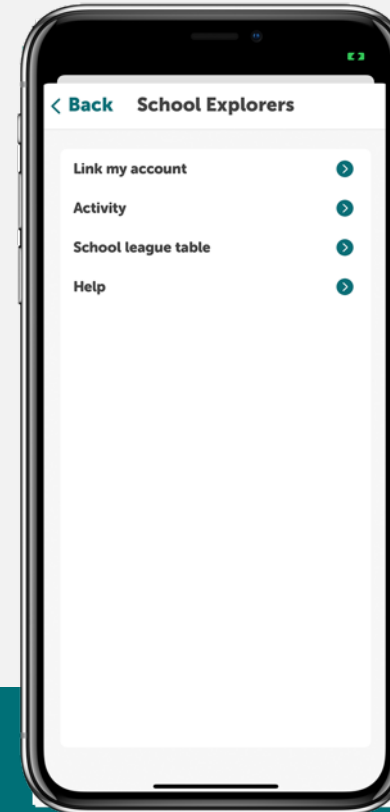
Just download the app and follow the menu choices below. When you have linked your account your points will be linked to your selected school.



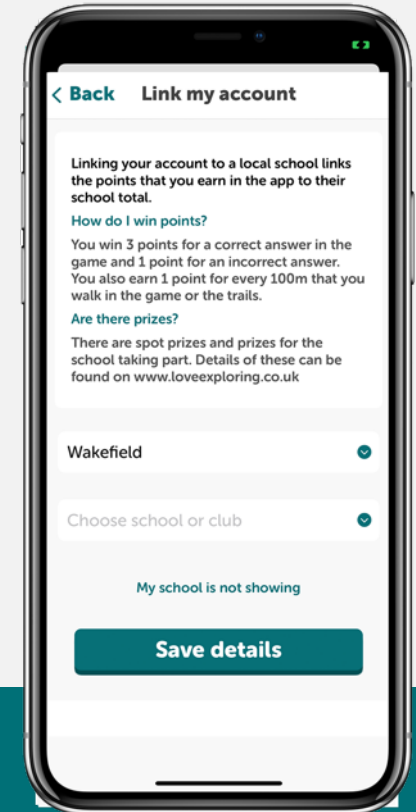

We are more active and learn better while we are playing and so all the activities in the app are designed to be fun.

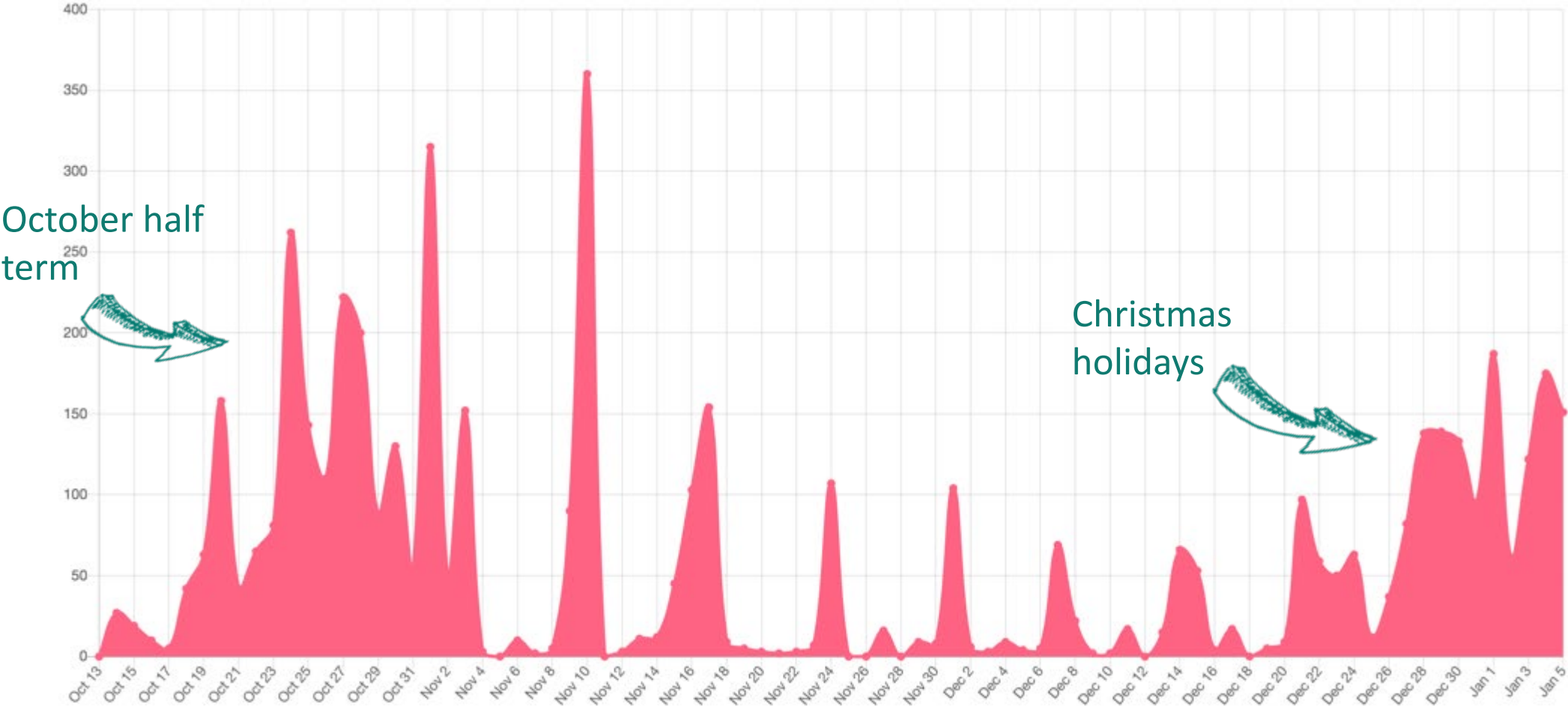

Prevalence of obese, severely obese, and obese or overweight Year 6 children, 2006/07 to 2020/21

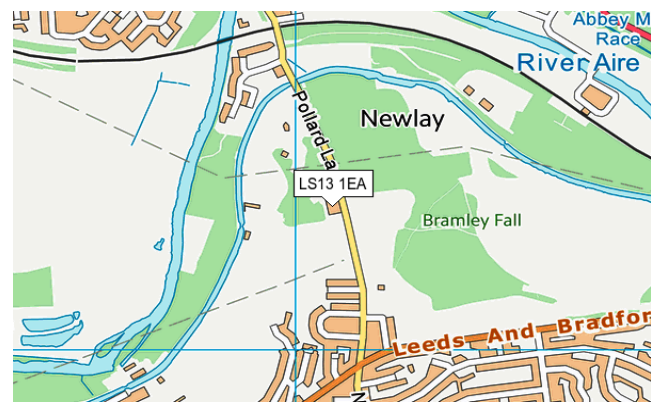
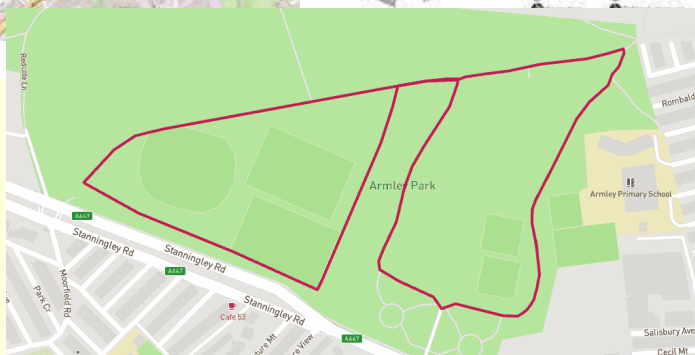
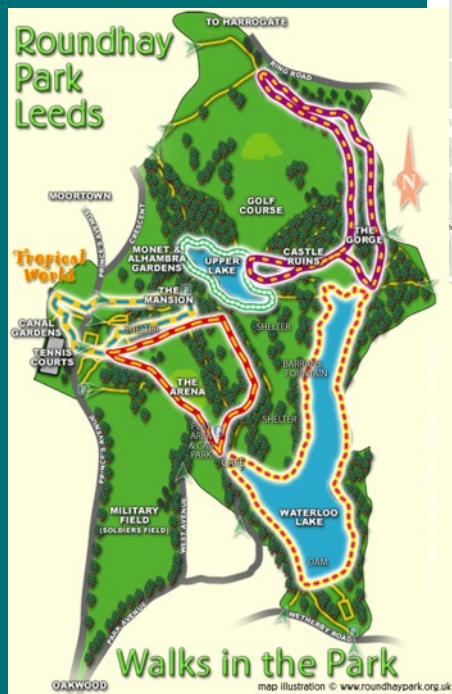
